



Accessing SentrySIS - Quickstart Guide




Once you have signed and completed a UKPAC IDPP, you will receive a welcome email for the SentrySIS platform. Select the link within the email.

Step 1




SentrySIS will open in your browser. Select reset password.

Step 2




Enter your email address and select reset. This will generate a password reset email.

Step 3




Return to your emails to find your password reset link from SentrySIS. Select the link within the email.

Step 4



SentrySIS will reopen in your browser. Create a new password and select submit. When you first login, you will be asked to complete the security check.

Step 5




On your first login, you will also need to sign the user agreement. To do this, type your name into the signature box then select accept.

Step 6



You're now ready to start using SentrySIS. You can login via browser or download and use the free app.


Download and open the free SentrySIS app. Login using your email address and password, set by following the prompts in your welcome email.

Step 1




From the home screen select the more icon.

Step 3




When you first login to the app you'll be asked to set a pin. Then select to allow notifications so that you'll know when a new alert or message comes through.




Once in the conversations menu, go to the bottom of the screen and select the new invitation notification.

Step 5




From this menu select the chat icon.




From the invitations menu, select the new chat group invitation. **Step 6**



Step 7 Select accept to join the chat group.



Exit the invitations menu by selecting to go back. **Step 8**



Step 9 You'll now see your new chat group. Select the chat group to join in the conversation.



Connect Live within SentrySIS works just like WhatsApp. You can connect with colleagues or members of a BCRP to chat and send pictures. Better still it's completely GDPR compliant. It provides a live communication tool, so you can share concerns and instantly alert each user to suspicious activities or excluded persons.
